Remembering:

- 1. What was the title of the book Josh's father wrote about Josh and his chess?
- 2. How did Josh feel after winning the 1990 Elementary School National Championships?

Understanding:

- 1. Why was it so important for Josh to play with those slightly better than himself?
- 2. Explain the importance of Josh's assessment of how Danny's mother should react to his failures.

Applying:

- 1. Have you ever experienced a time where you have been strengthened by competing with those on a higher level than yourself?
- 2. How did your parent/ guardian react when you faced failure or loss? Do you think it helped you grow?

Analyzing:

- 1. Analyze the technique of making the game "messy" and how Josh used it to his advantage.
- 2. Analyze how Josh responded to his situation in Qatar, and what allowed him to succeed under unfamiliar circumstances.

Evaluating:

- 1. Do you agree with Josh's example about Danny and how a mother should teach her child after failure?
- 2. Evaluate the benefits of allowing a child to experience failure.

Creating:

- 1. Describe a situation where you have experienced failure and create a new outcome of how you would respond to the situation based on the book's response.
